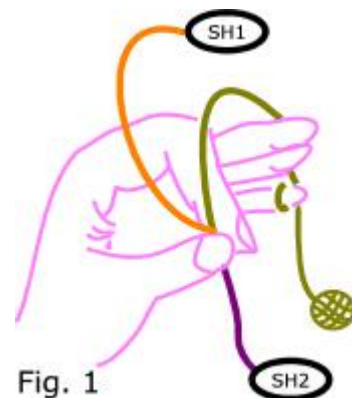


Materials required – 2 shuttles and a ball thread.

Tie all 3 ends together or proceed from previous element in the tatting.

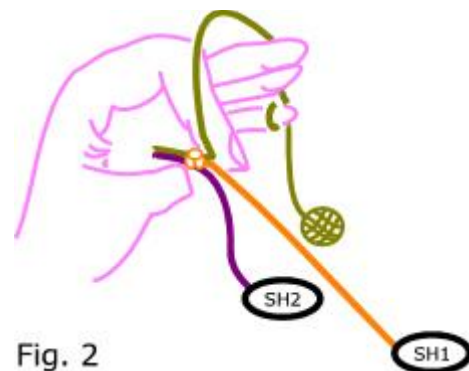
NOTE: The chain thread will be the core thread and will never show in the work.

Hold as you would normally hold the thread ready to make a chain but with SH1 over the back of the hand. See fig. 1



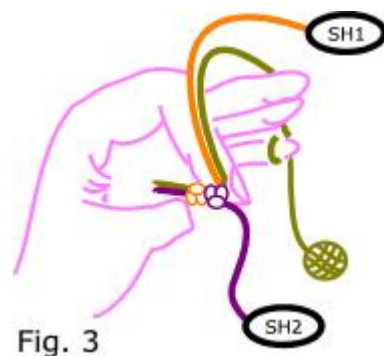
Using SH1 make first ds on the ball thread without flipping the knot as in the Daisy Picot technique. (colour of SH1 thread will show as ds).

Hang SH1 over the back of the hand as before. See fig. 2



Take SH2 & make ds without turning the knot (as in 2nd side of SR) SH2 thread will show as ds. See fig. 3.

Repeat.



This method is faster than dropping shuttles, turning the work etc.
As many ds can be worked this way on either side of the core thread as required.
